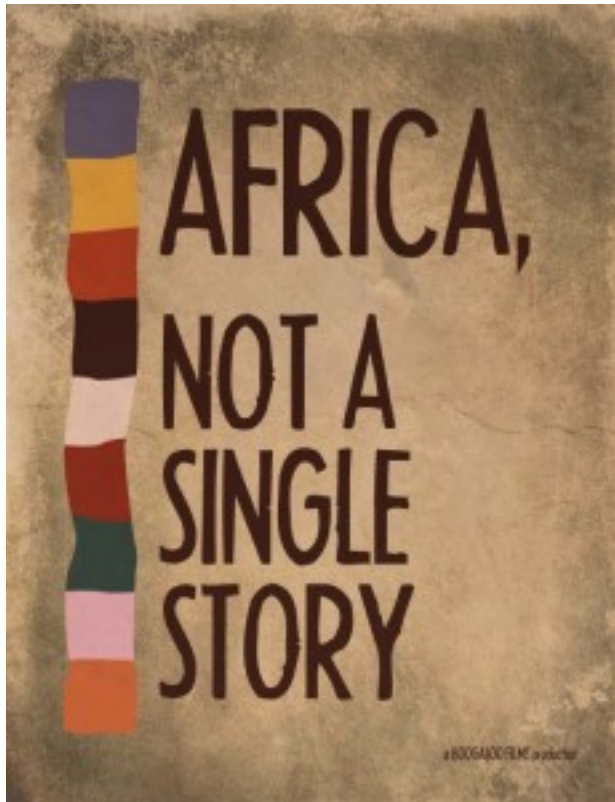


## Tuesday and Thursday - SSR on Africa
